



Prof. Senem DURUEL ERKILIÇ

Born in Istanbul in 1971, she graduated from the Department of Cinema and Television at Mimar Sinan University in 1993. She worked on various advertising projects, television series, and feature films, and directed short films and documentaries. She received her M.A. degree in Film and Television Production from Chapman University in the United States in 1997 and completed her proficiency in art (equivalent to a doctoral degree in the arts) at the Department of Cinema and Television, Mimar Sinan University, in 2002. She was awarded the title of Associate Professor in 2008 and Professor in 2013.

Since 2004, she has been a faculty member in the Department of Radio, Television and Cinema at Mersin University Faculty of Communication. As a founding member of the department, she served as Head of the Department of Radio, Television and Cinema between 2004 and 2008. She was Vice Dean of the Faculty of Communication at Mersin University from 2008 to 2014 and Dean from 2014 to 2020. She currently continues to serve as Head of the Department of Media, Culture and Urban Studies at the same university.

Her research focuses on Turkish cinema, cinema, history and memory, cinema and society, the relationship between cinema and space, and film language. She has published articles in edited volumes and academic journals. She is the author of the book *History and Memory in Turkish Cinema* (2014).
